New Laws

Apr 3: Dennis King won a second term as premier of Prince Edward Island after his Progressive Conservatives captured a majority of 22 seats in the provincial election. Despite having won only 3 seats, the Liberals will form the Official Opposition after the Greens fell to 2 seats. Turnout was a record low of 68.5%, down from 77.66% in 2019.

May 6: That's the deadline to comment on proposed changes to a pair of WCB policies: Audit of Employer Accounts (<u>POL-45</u>), and Medications (<u>POL-120</u>).

Mar 9: The PEI WCB warned of a possible phishing scam on Facebook Messenger involving individuals posing as WCB officials promising prize money for clicking a link.
