Infectious Illnesses

Aug 10: The WCB published a <u>new guide</u> to help employers develop and implement a plan to prevent infections and communicable diseases in the workplace.

Action Point: Use the <u>OHSI Infection Exposure Control Plan</u> template to prevent infectious illnesses at your workplace

New Laws

Jul 29: Newly effective <u>amendments</u> to the PEI *Building Codes Act* Regulations took effect to reduce wait times for building permits by allowing the government to create a new Intern Level building official with authority to approve smaller-scale building projects such as single-story accessory buildings and decks.

Workplace Violence

Aug 2: PEI and the federal government signed a historic bilateral agreement under which the province will receive \$9.6 million over 4 years to implement the National Action Plan to End Gender-Based Violence in the province.
