New Laws

Aug 8: The Governments of Canada and Nunavut signed a new 10-year agreement under which the territory will receive \$94.5 million from the Canada Community Building Fund (CCBF) to support local infrastructure development projects over the first 5 years, starting with \$18 million in 2024-2025.

Jul 15: The GN issued a revised Polar Bear Total Allowable Harvest Order, setting the Davis Strait Polar Bear Population for the Baffin Region at 64.

Environmental

Jul 29: The federal government announced that it will invest over \$19 million to fund 3 different Indigenous-led clean energy projects in Nauyasat, Rankin Inlet, and Baker Lake to reduce diesel fuel consumption, promote development, and create jobs in Nunavut.
