Transportation Safety

Mar 28: Under <u>Bill 33</u>, driving 50-80 km/h over the speed limit would result in vehicle impoundment for 7 days, in addition to a \$500 fine and 5 points off a licence. The bill also requires people whose licences have expired for 5 years or more to re-take the written and road test to get a new one.

New Laws

Apr 3: The federal government increased New Brunswick's immigration allocation for 2023 by 67% to 5,500 places. Further increases are expected for 2024 and 2025 allocations.

New Laws

Mar 16: The 2023 New Brunswick provincial budget earmarks \$6.87 million for 4 educational programs to train high school students, minorities and persons changing careers for future work in the manufacturing sector.
