# **Drugs & Alcohol**

Feb 28: The GNWT released a 2-year work plan outlining measures it intends to take to prevent addictions and support the recovery of residents who have addictions.

**Action Point:** Use the <u>OHSI Substance Abuse Compliance Game Plan</u> to curb drugs and alcohol at your workplace

## **New Laws**

Feb 20: The GNWT joined a program helping Canadian employers connect with and hire skilled refugees overseas. Cost of recruiting an employee through the Economic Mobility Pathways Pilot is between \$5,000 and \$10,000, including visa, relocation and temporary accommodation on arrival. Other jurisdictions in the Pilot include BC, Manitoba, New Brunswick, Newfoundland, Nova Scotia, Ontario, PEI and Yukon.

#### **Environmental**

Feb 28: The federal government announced that it will provide \$1 million to support the Tu Cho Fisher's Cooperative and its Winter Fishery Enhancement and Innovation Project. The funds will be furnished through the Canadian Northern Economic Development Agency (CanNor).
