Incident Reporting

Jan 9: Workers can now use the PEI's WCB Online Services portal to report workplace injuries and illnesses and start the workers comp claims process. Previously, only employers and healthcare providers had access to the portal.

Action Point: Use the resources on the OHSI Incident Reporting <u>Compliance Centre</u> to ensure proper incident investigation and reporting at your workplace

New Laws

Dec 19: PEI and the federal government signed a bilateral agreement that will provide more than \$94 million in federal funding over the next 3 years to improve access and quality of the province's healthcare system.

Workers Comp

Jan 15: The PEI WCB ended <u>public consultations</u> on the agency's proposed 3-year Strategic Plan for 2024-2026.

Workers Comp

Feb 28: That's the last day for PEI employers to submit their workers comp payroll data reports listing their actual 2023 payroll cost figures and projected expenses in 2024 to the WCB to avoid the risk of late fees, interest and penalties.
