Infectious Illness

Feb 7: The GN issued a public service announcement warning residents about the risks of tuberculosis. While TB is transmitted through the air, casual interactions in public spaces pose little risk. It usually takes prolonged exposure in close quarters with someone who has untreated active TB, since the bacteria can linger in the air in confined spaces.

Action Point: Use the [OHS Insider Infection Exposure Control Plan](#) template to guard against TB, measles, and other potential infectious illness outbreaks at your workplace.

New Laws

Feb 10: The GN, B2Gold Corp., and Kitikmeot Inuit Association signed a Memorandum of Understanding to strengthen collaboration on economic development, training, and community wellbeing in the Kitikmeot Region. The MOU establishes a framework for ongoing cooperation among the parties to promote responsible resource development in Nunavut.

Workers' Comp

Feb 28: February 29th is the deadline for Nunavut employers to submit their workers' comp Annual Payroll Report listing their actual 2024 payroll costs and projected costs for 2025 to the WSCC to avoid potential 2% late fees, interest, and penalties.
