New Laws

Sep 9: The Canada Community-Building Fund will provide Nunavut over \$18,750,000 for the 2025-2026 fiscal year. The GN will direct the funds to municipalities in the territories to support high-priority local housing and essential infrastructure development across 19 different project categories ranging from bridges to wastewater.

Environmental

Aug 20: Nunavut completed 4 large-scale solar panel system projects this summer in a push to reduce reliance on diesel power. Ranging in output from 100 to 150 kilowatts, the systems were installed in community centers located in Clyde River, Arctic Bay, Grise Fiord, and Pond Inlet.

Environmental

Aug 28: Nunavut and the Northwest Territories signed an updated Memorandum of Understanding to work together to manage shared populations of caribou herds. The MOU provides for sharing of caribou monitoring data, research on barren-ground caribou range predators and the addition of Peary caribou and Dolphin and Union caribou herds.
