## LAWS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

### Training

March 23 is the deadline for non-profit organizations, training institutions, municipal corporations, and Inuit organizations [to apply](#) for Targeted Labour Market Program (TLMP) training funding. Priorities for the 2026-2027 fiscal year include training: i. in smaller communities outside Iqaluit, Rankin Inlet, and Cambridge Bay; ii. in mining and the trades; and iii. for persons with disabilities.

### Training

Feb 16: Nonprofits, municipal governments, and individuals in Nunavut can now apply for Nunavut Mine Training Fund (NMTF) support for community-based training initiatives in the mining industry and related fields. Examples of eligible training programs include pre-employment, introduction to mining, environmental monitoring, and operation of heavy equipment. Deadline [to apply](#): March 31.

### Infectious Illness

Feb 18: The Department of Health reminded Nunavummiut about the importance of keeping up to date with immunizations. It's especially important that children receive routine immunizations on time to protect them from serious vaccine-preventable diseases such as measles, pertussis, and RSV.
